Transparent bottles

Colorless bottles for juice, liquor, 1.8L issho-bin bottles, bottles for seasoning, coffee, powder, preserved seaweed, jam, oral medication, etc.

● Also clear and frosted glass bottles are included.

● Rinse bottles thoroughly before disposal.

Brown bottles

Brown bottles for juice, liquor, nutrition drinks and oral medication, etc.

● Dispose of 1.8L issho-bin bottles and beer bottles that are not broken as “**refillable bottles.**”

● Rinse bottles thoroughly before disposal.

Other color bottles

Colored bottles (except for transparent, brown, milky-colored bottles for juice, liquor, nutrition drinks, etc.)

● Dispose of any bottle whose color cannot be judged as “**Other colored bottle.**”

● Rinse bottles thoroughly before disposal.

Refillable bottles

Brown and green 1.8L issho-bin bottles and commercial beer bottles (oversized bottles are okay.)

● Dispose of a 1.8L issho-bin bottle that contained oil, a broken 1.8L issho-bin bottle, or a beer bottle and a bottle with a label peeled off according to the color of each bottle.

● Rinse bottles thoroughly before disposal.

Glass / ceramics

Sheet glass, glasses, glass products (vases, etc.), fragments of bottle / glass broken into pieces, Codd-neck / Ramuné bottles, plates / bowls, household ceramics (flower pots, etc.)

● Concrete, bricks and roof tiles **cannot be collected.**

● Includes bottles for household agricultural chemicals, herbicides, etc., milky-colored and difficult-to-clean bottles for cosmetics

Pots / hardware

Pots, wires (30cm or shorter), metal products and knives (*Dispose of razors as “**hazardous materials.**”)

● Dispose of aluminum foil, aluminum containers for cooking, and stove covers as “**combustible garbage.**”

Small electrical products

Products as large as 30cm

Electrical products (dryers, cameras, irons, home telephones / game machines, etc.) and electrical cords, equipment (weight scales, etc.), watches, clocks, electric / clockwork toys

● Remove electrical cords from products and bundle them before disposal.

● Products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act (TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, washing machines, etc.) and personal computers cannot be collected.

Medium-sized garbage

Products as large as 60cm

Products including metals (videocassette recorders, stoves, electric pots, microwaves, gas stoves, sewing machines, etc.)

● Electric fans, vacuum cleaners, bicycles and umbrellas over 60cm can also be collected.

● Strollers, carts, child safety seats, etc., **cannot be collected.**

● Remove electrical cords from products and bind them before disposal.

Hazardous materials

Fluorescent tubes, light bulbs, razors, needles, mercury thermometers, lighters, mirrors, and cans / bottles for insecticides and household agricultural chemicals

● Dispose of plastic bottles for household herbicide, fragrance, dehumidifying agent, etc., as “**combustible garbage.**”

Dry-cell batteries

Alkaline / manganese dry-cell batteries (D, C, AA, AAA, N, AAAA and 9V batteries)

● Return button batteries, rechargeable batteries and other batteries to stores.

PET bottles



← Bottle containers with this mark for drinking water, liquor, soy sauce, etc.

● Dispose of PET bottles used for arts & crafts as “**combustible garbage.**”

● Remove the labels and dispose of them as “**plastic containers and packaging.**”

PET bottle caps

● Dispose of plastic caps of containers other than PET bottles as “**plastic containers and packaging.**”

White trays

“Plain white trays” used for packing meat, fish, vegetables, fruits, meals, etc., from supermarkets, etc.

● Dispose of natto containers, cup yakisoba containers and bento containers as “**plastic containers and packaging.**”

Completely empty plastic containers that contained food, liquid, etc., and rinse them thoroughly before disposal. As for plastic containers with dirt that cannot be easily removed, cut them into small pieces and dispose of them as “**combustible garbage.**”

Clothing and cloth

Does not include underwear and socks.

Fabric products and cloth such as towels, sheets, etc.

● It is not necessary to remove fasteners or buttons from clothing.

● Put them in a transparent bag, to keep them dry before disposal.

● Cut curtains into a size of about 30cm squared and divide them into several pieces as “**combustible garbage**” or cut them into a size of 50cm squared and directly bring them to ECO-EIGHT YATSUSHIRO.

Metal lids

Metal caps such as bottle caps, screw-in caps, can tabs

● Dispose of corks as “**combustible garbage.**”



Cans (steel cans / aluminum cans)



← Cans with these marks

● There are some collection stations where steel cans and aluminum cans are separated from each other and collected depending on the neighborhood association. Please confirm the collection method.

● Make sure to make a hole in spray cans, etc., to thoroughly remove gas. (**Keep away from fire**)

● Dispose of severely rusted or dirty cans as “Pots / hardware.”

● Lightly rinse them before disposal.

Plastic containers and packaging



← Plastic containers, packaging, plastic wrap, etc., with this mark

Plastic containers and inserts that contained food for sale, plastic lids and plastic bottles for shampoo, detergent, etc.

Outer packaging and cling wrap used to cover foods and commodities

● Even when plastic bottles for household herbicides, fertilizer bags, fragrance, dehumidifying agents, etc., are rinsed, remnants and odors cannot be thoroughly removed. Therefore, dispose of them as “**combustible garbage.**”

★ Take extra precautions so that no residue remains.

★ Home healthcare garbage (tubes, plastic bags, syringes, etc.) **cannot be collected** as resources, even when the ♻️ marks are displayed. Dispose of them as “**combustible garbage.**”

● Rinse bottles thoroughly before disposal.

Plastic products

★ Remove the metal parts.

Basins, storage containers (Tupperware, etc.), toys, plastic hangers, cases (for videotapes / cassette tapes), CDs, DVDs and MDs (bodies / cases)

● Put large-sized products such as storage containers, kerosene cans and planters in one area of the collection station.

● Rinse planters thoroughly to remove soil before disposal.

● Dry kerosene cans before disposal.

● Cut blue tarpaulin into a size of 50cm squared.

● Corrugated sheets, PVC pipes, gutters, automotive parts, coolers, carrier bags, child car seats, etc., **cannot be collected.**

Foam polystyrene

Foam polystyrene such as cushion materials and cold insulation boxes

● Cut foam polystyrene boxes for fish and severely dirtied or degraded foam polystyrene into small pieces and dispose of them as “**combustible garbage.**”

Video / cassette tapes

Entire videotapes and cassette tapes

● Dispose of videotape cases as “**plastic products.**”

The sorting collection containers for resources are designated by region.

Neighborhood associations manage the collection stations. Please follow the rules and manners for garbage sorting so as not to trouble others.

Paper containers and packaging



← Paper boxes, wrapping paper, paper bags, paper cups, etc., with this mark

Paper boxes and inserts, wrapping paper and paper bags used for the sale of goods (food, commercial drugs, cigarettes, tissue paper, miscellaneous daily goods, etc.)

● Remove films, seals, plastics, metals to the maximum extent possible before disposal.

Cartons



← Cartons with this mark

● Rinse and cut open the container to dry before disposal.

● When a straw is attached to the container, remove its plastic wrap.

● When aluminum foil is put on the inside of a container, dispose of it as “**paper containers and packaging.**”

Cardboard



← corrugated paper

*Includes cardboard without this mark.

● Remove metal parts such as clamps.

● When the surface of corrugated cardboard is coated, dispose of it as “**combustible garbage.**”

Newspapers / flyers

● It is not necessary to separate newspapers from advertising inserts.

Magazines / miscellaneous recyclable paper

School textbooks, catalogs, weekly magazines, paperbacks, comic magazines, informational magazines, dictionaries and miscellaneous recyclable paper (flyers, brochures and calendars other than newspaper inserts)

● Remove the thick front covers of dictionaries, etc., and DVDs and plastic bags, etc., from magazines. (Dispose of the front covers and plastic bags as “**combustible garbage.**”)

Stack paper and bundle it crosswise with string before disposal.

*Dispose of wet paper as “**combustible garbage.**”

Do not dispose of garbage on a rainy day, and dispose of it on the next “resource collection day.”

Uncollectable items Industrial waste, agricultural vinyl, medical waste, motorbike / automotive parts, drums, tool sheds, fire extinguishers, LP gas cylinders, pianos, concrete, bricks, house waste materials, roof tiles, incinerators, motors, pumps, etc. As for items that cannot be collected as garbage above, ECO-EIGHT YATSUSHIRO cannot collect them. Consult with a certified waste-disposal service vendor, etc.
